Curriculum Intent

Provide pupils with the knowledge and skills they need in order to take advantage of opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.

- Students are given the opportunity to explore their own thoughts on each topic

- Students are encouraged to develop their critical analysis and evaluation skills to enable them to form and express their own opinions, whilst remaining respectful to the views of others.
