Spanish Exchange Update

I am writing to inform you that there is a slight amendment to the Colegio San Buenaventura's schedule for their visit to the UK.

This amendment has been made to make things easier for everybody. Students will no longer go bowling on Monday 31st March as this would make things complicated (ie, in the previous plan the Spanish students had to be collected by the host family from Ruislip Manor Station at 6.00pm, be fed and dropped off at Park Royal Leisure Centre by 7.30pm and then collected at the end of the night).

The new arrangements for the afternoon of Monday 31st March are as follows. All Bishop Ramsey students that take part in the Exchange must be outside the McDonalds restaurant in Ruislip High Street by 5.00pm (please note that they have to make their way there by themselves - 10 minute walk from school) where they will be supervised by Mrs Hofmann and myself. At 5.00pm the Spanish cohort will also arrive at the McDonalds.

All students will have dinner at McDonalds and will have an opportunity, after dinner, to wander around Ruislip High Street.

At 6.30pm your son/daughter, along with their Spanish exchange student, should be collected from outside McDonalds. Alternatively, if you wish your child and their exchange student to make their own way home, please indicate your permission by emailing me at gbueno.312@lgflmail.org before Friday 21st March.

Please note that all students will have one of the menus of the restaurant and that the cost of it will be covered with some of the remaining amount left in the budget.

All our students will be expected to remain inside the McDonalds premises during this joint activity and will not be able to leave the premises without authorisation from either Mr Bueno or Mrs Hofmann. If they are allowed to leave the premises they will be expected to stay within close vicinity of the McDonalds and always stay in a group.
