“Romeo and Juliet” Theatre Trip

The English and Drama Departments are pleased to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to take part in a theatre trip to see ‘Romeo and Juliet on Thursday 1st October at Harrow Arts Centre, Uxbridge Road, Hatch End, HA5 4EA.

Following the success of ‘The Taming of the Shrew’ and ‘A Midsummer Night’s Dream’, Immersion Theatre return to Harrow once again with this exhilarating adaptation of William Shakespeare’s iconic tragedy, ‘Romeo & Juliet’.

Boldly relocating the action to 1980’s England, this tragic story of forbidden love and bitter rivalry promises to be a gritty, visceral and highly accessible spectacle infused with heart-break, danger and comedy – perfect for both the seasoned theatre goer and budding literary enthusiast.

The production runs from 7.30pm – 9.30pm. We will meet at the entrance to the theatre by 7.00pm at the latest. As is usual in theatres, late arrivals will only be admitted in the interval.

This trip is open to any students in Years 8-13 even if they are not studying Literature or Drama.

This trip is voluntary but would be advantageous as part of our studies of Shakespeare or as an introduction to live Shakespeare.

The cost of this trip is **£9.00 (non refundable)**. This will cover the cost of the ticket but does not cover transport costs. Please note, students will be expected to make their own way to and from the Arts Centre.

Payment should be made via ParentPay by **Friday 18th September 2015**. Please select ‘Romeo and Juliet 2015-16’. It is anticipated that there will be a high level of interest in this trip but places are limited, therefore places will be allocated on a strict first-come, first-served basis as payments are received. Should the maximum number be reached before the deadline, this item will be closed on ParentPay. Payments will not be accepted after this date.
