**A2 History Trip – Imperial War Museum**

As part of the A2 History course, students are required to understand the impact of war and revolution on Russia 1855-1964. For this reason the History Department has organised an opportunity to take part in a visit to the Imperial War Museum. During this visit your son/daughter will be primarily focusing on the impact of both the First World War on society and the military, and fully appreciating the effect of these conflicts on Europe, as well as visiting other relevant exhibitions.

The visit will take place on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2015 and your son/daughter will be required to meet Miss Robinson outside the Imperial War Museum for registration, by 9.45am. Students will be dismissed around 1.30 -2.00pm. The visit is voluntary. However, we believe that this will be a valuable addition to your son/daughter's A2 History course. The details of how to get to the Imperial War Museum and arrangements for the day are included on page 3 of this letter.

The cost of the actual visit is free. However, your son/daughter will be expected to travel to and from the Imperial War Museum on their own and cover the cost of this, as well as the cost of lunch.

All students who travel as part of a group represent Bishop Ramsey School. Therefore the highest standards of behaviour and conduct are expected as a matter of course. Your son/daughter is expected to wear clothing in line with Bishop Ramsey's Sixth Form Dress Code.

Students should bring with them any required medication, asthma inhalers, epipens. Mobile phones and other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk.

## Imperial War Museum Visit

- You need to arrive in time to meet Miss Robinson outside the Imperial War Museum at 9.45am.
- It is suggested that you travel in small groups.
- If you are travelling from a Metropolitan line station the best route to take is:
  - Met line to Baker Street & change to the Bakerloo Line and disembark at Lambeth North.
- If you are travelling from a Central line station the best route to take is:
  - Central Line to Oxford Circus & change to the Bakerloo line and disembark at Lambeth North.
- Remember to check for line delays on the day and engineering works.
- The Imperial War Museum is a short walk from Lambeth North Station and is clearly signposted from the station.
