



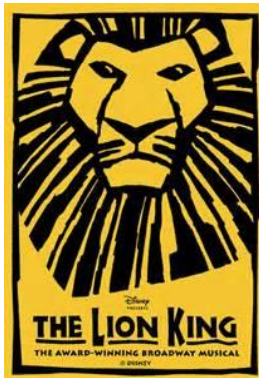

Dear Parents/Carers

'The Lion King' Theatre Trip

Firstly I would like to congratulate Year 7 on an excellent start to their time at Bishop Ramsey. They have made an excellent impression on the staff, who have high expectations for them in the years to come.



Secondly, I am writing to inform you of the Christmas Theatre Trip that we are running. We will be going to see The Lion King at the Lyceum Theatre on Wednesday 9th December. We have run similar trips in the past and they have been very popular and a great way to celebrate the achievements of the first term.

During the Spring Term the RE, Art, Drama, Music and Art departments will be following a joint curriculum based on The Lion King. It would be advantageous for the students to have seen the stage show before studying this unit of work but this trip is not compulsory. However we have reserved enough tickets for the whole year group to be able to go.

We will be leaving school around 5.00pm and take the opportunity to view the Christmas lights in central London. We will be returning by 11.00pm. Final arrangements for pick ups and drop offs will be given closer to the date.

The cost of the coach and theatre ticket is £30.00. Payment should be made via ParentPay by Monday 28th September 2015. Please select 'The Lion King 2015-16'. Unfortunately we are unable to accept payments after this date.

Your permission is granted for your son/daughter:


- to attend the trip
