Invitation to Re-Sit LITB1

I am writing to let you know that your son/daughter has been identified as a student who has been advised to re-sit the English Literature AS exam (LITB1). I would like to make some early preparations for those students and have outlined some initial steps that they can take to be exam ready in May 2016.

Please be advised that the deadline for notifying the Exams Officer that a student intends to resit an examination is 9.00am on Friday 11th December. You can access the form on the attached word document 'Re-Sit Entry Form'.

We hope to be able to offer our re-sit students some extra classes in the Spring term, but in the meantime it is essential that they begin their own independent study as soon as possible. I would like to make the following suggestions for home study at this stage:

- Read the **AS Literature exam presentation PowerPoint** first – it outlines the papers and reminds students of which assessment objectives they should cover for each question
- Collect a copy of their **marked LITB1 2015 script** from the English Office if they have not already done so, and keep this in a safe place
- Read over their script carefully and make notes on our **KS5 student feedback forms** as to where assessment objectives were not met for each question – we have many spare copies of these blue feedback forms in the English Office
- Re-read '**Enduring Love**' carefully using the **two pdf documents** attached (**the Workbook and Student Tasks**). Students should make new notes on the text from this independent study and use these to supplement their revision notes from last year
- Read through the **Powerpoint on Narrative** and do the tasks to remind themselves of the concepts and language of the Aspects of Narrative unit
- Read through the **pdf on Exam notes** and do the tasks with reference to 'Enduring Love'.

I will write to you again in January with suggestions for revision of 'The Great Gatsby' and in March for revision of our poetry on Rossetti and Frost.

I do hope that our students resitting will have the benefit of a good A Level result in 2016 as a reward for their efforts. Thank you for your continued support and please do not hesitate to get in touch if you would like any further help on guiding your son/daughter.
