Year 9 Reports

Your child's report has now been completed and is available on the Parent Portal. By clicking on 'Subjects' the report should be visible. We have tried to make the process of downloading the report as straightforward as possible. There are two icons at the top right of the page, one has a printer icon which you need to click to print the report and the other a disc to save the report to your computer.

The report includes a comment by subject staff on the progress that your child has made as well as targets for improvement and grades for Attitude to Learning (a key for which is at the bottom of the report). In some cases the Ability to Meet Deadlines including Homework column is blank because, as with PE, no homework is set.

Most subjects have the current sub-level that your child is working at, with Science and ICT giving a predicted grade. This is the best prediction that can be made at the moment as to the grade that they are likely to achieve in their GCSE examination based on current performance.

We should like to congratulate students who are doing as well or better than could be expected and ask for your support for staff where we believe that your child could do better.

We hope that this report gives you a clear picture of your child's current progress, as well as an update on the information that you received on Academic Tutorial Day. Your child's tracking data will be updated again in the Summer term.

You will have the opportunity to discuss the report and your child's future pathway at the Parents' Evening on 4th February. However, if you have any questions regarding the above or any other assessment issues please do not hesitate to contact one of us.
