Year 12 End of Year

Year 12 are now back into lessons and are progressing with the next part of A-Level work. Thank you to those of you who have been keeping us informed about Open Days and University visits.

On the school calendar you will see that we have 2 enrichment days for the rest of the school on Thursday and Friday next week (7th and 8th July). Year 12 students are **not** expected in school as staff are involved in these.

There is an opportunity which I wanted to share for students who do not wish to go to University - 'Alternatives to HE at 18'. This is an event hosted at Kingston College, Kingston Hall Road, KT1 2AQ on Thursday 7th July starting at 9:45am. There is a full programme of alternative provision which students may not be aware of – HNC, HNDs, foundation degrees and apprenticeships. It looks interesting and I have made a provisional booking. Please let me know if your son/daughter is interested and I can give them the full information, as well as confirm their place. They would need to travel independently to the event.

Year 12 are not required to attend Sports Day on Thursday 14th July unless they are helping with events or supporting their House. They should listen for messages on Wednesday in case it is cancelled due to the weather as in this instance lessons will continue.

We will be putting the enrolment form for Year 13 on the website and Fronter. Students will need to achieve a minimum of Grade D in a subject to continue to Year 13. We will have an enrolment surgery on results day where we can discuss options for those with problems, but otherwise students should just hand in the form on that day or e-mail it to me as soon as they can.

In September all returning students will have an individual interview with their Form Tutor – times will be on Fronter. These will be held on Wednesday 7th September and Thursday 8th September. Year 13 lessons begin on 9th September.

I hope the summer break is a successful (and dry) one for you and your family.
