Shoebbox Appeal

Each year, as part of the Rotary Shoebbox Appeal, we as a school fill shoeboxes with presents to be sent to families in Eastern Europe who are unlikely to receive presents. We hope to send around 300 shoeboxes – that is 10 per Form.

During the 'Learning for Life' session on **Friday 8th December**, students will put together their shoeboxes with their Form. During that week students need to bring in items they are going to put in their Form shoeboxes. The boxes are packed receiver specific, for example, for a female teenager, 4 year old male or 70 year old female.

Suggested items for the boxes:

- Toys:** matchbox type cars, small bouncy balls, yo-yos, dolls, action figures, colouring books, crayons, felt tips pens, notebooks, Lego, skipping ropes, jigsaws, cards
- Teenager:** make-up, toiletries, sportswear, hats, gloves, deodorants, costume, jewellery, socks, football memorabilia, writing materials
- Household:** shampoo, soap, toothpaste, antiseptic cream, toothbrush
 (For Families and Senior Citizens)
- Baby:** baby clothes, blanket, baby shampoo, baby wipes, etc.
 (For new mothers and babies up to 12 months)

Please **do not** send in chocolate or sweets, war related toys or anything that needs batteries.

We hope you can support us in this venture.
