Test results for Chemistry Topics 8 and 9

Recently, your son/daughter completed 2 Chemistry tests lasting 30 minutes each. Class results are expressed as an overall percentage, with each test having a possible 30 marks. I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter achieved below the class average in both of these tests and this raises concerns in regard to what grade they are likely to achieve in their final GCSE. Your son/daughter should be aware of their level of achievement. If however they are not, it will be discussed with them in the next available lesson.

To aid in the progress of your son/daughter, we feel that they would benefit from extra guided work to help address gaps in subject knowledge and provide them with further exam practice.
