Dear Parent/Carer,

GCSE PE Theory - Compulsory Intervention Revision Sessions

We are writing to inform you that your son/daughter has been identified as requiring intervention for the theory components of the GCSE PE course. This is as a result of achieving below their target grade in their mock examinations. The intervention will run as a series of after school revision sessions as detailed below:

- Session 1- Monday 19th February 3.15pm to 4.15pm with Mr Drury in ZG9
- Session 2- Monday 5th March 3.15pm to 4.15pm with Mr Drury in ZG9
- Session 3- Monday 12th March 3.15pm to 4.15pm with Mr Drury in ZG9
- Session 4- Monday 19th March 3.15pm to 4.15pm with Mr Drury in ZG9 (Time and date tbc.)

Attendance at these sessions is compulsory. We expect all students to arrive on time and be prepared to work for the full hour. This involves bringing their PE exercise book and any revision guides and resources that they may have. Exemplary behaviour is expected; without this your son/daughter will not benefit fully from the support provided in a small-scale group.

We are using an intervention proforma provided by a company called PiXL Independence Resources. It works on a three stage process - Diagnosis, Therapy and Testing. Diagnosis involves a short conversation with your son/daughter to identify topic areas of weakness from both mock theory papers. Following this, sessions 1-3 will involve targeted revision on the topics. Your son/daughter will also be expected to work independently on the targeted topics using the PiXL Independence Resources in their own time. Details of this can be found below. The final stage of the process is Testing. Your son/daughter will be given an individualised exam paper that only contains questions on the topics identified in the initial Diagnosis. It is hoped this will then improve their attainment in the areas they found difficult in the mock exams.

Following on from the intervention sessions detailed above, generalised revision will be provided for all students and your son/daughter will still have access to the PiXL Independence Resources to use in their own time.

PiXL Independence Resources

By accessing the website and using the login details provided in lessons, your son/daughter can access a wide range of PE revision resources and questions, free of charge. All students will be shown how to navigate the website to access the resources in class. We strongly advise that your son/daughter uses these resources to supplement the work carried out in the intervention sessions.
