Your son/daughter has recently been offered a place at our Sixth Form. The following Induction details were sent to you via maildrop. Non return of those details may result in your son/daughter being unable to take part in the Induction programme.

Sixth Form Induction Course 2018

The Induction Course will take place from Tuesday 3rd July to Wednesday 4th July inclusive. This is an integral part of the Sixth Form programme and we would strongly recommend prospective students to attend.

The aim is to help students prepare for life and work in the Sixth Form by meeting new people and getting a flavour of the subjects they have chosen, as well as to provide them with some work to do over the summer. The Induction Course has proved to be very successful and enjoyable in previous years and we hope to continue the tradition this year.

On **Monday 2nd July** students wanting to take **A Level courses** in either **Maths, Biology, Physics, Chemistry and/or PE** should come in to school to take a test. This, along with their GCSE result, will qualify them to take these subjects if chosen. Students should come to the Hub at 8.50am. The PE test will require fitness clothing to be worn. Information about the content of all the tests is on the school website in the Sixth Form area, on the Entry Requirements tab.

Tuesday 3rd July

Students should arrive promptly for a 9.00am briefing session in the School Hall. The day will be spent sampling A Level introductory lessons along with induction activities.

Students will be given preparatory work for September. It is important that this is completed. They should bring a packed lunch and drinks. Students should follow the Sixth Form dress code on this day (please refer to the Sixth Form Course Guide). Key colours for trousers and skirts are Navy, Dark Brown, Charcoal Grey and Black. Clothing should be formal (suit style) – not skin tight.

Wednesday 4th July

Outdoor pursuits at HOAC, Harefield, led by qualified instructors from the centre. We will meet at Highgrove Leisure Centre coach drop off point at 8.45am, travelling to and from HOAC by coach, returning at 4.00pm approximately. Please arrive promptly. Students should wear appropriate clothing for outdoor activities. It is likely that they will get wet therefore they are advised to bring a change of clothing and a towel. Students should also bring a packed lunch and drinks.

Your permission is granted for your son/daughter:

- to attend the course, including our off-site activity at HOAC
- to be given a mild painkiller (eg. paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader
- to receive medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carer you cannot be contacted.


You confirm/understand:

- that your son/daughter's medical details are correct on the Parent Portal and you will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the course
- that a high standard of behaviour is expected from all students throughout the course. Should your son/daughter's behaviour either in school or during the course, not be acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the programme and any monies received will not be refunded
- that your son/daughter can swim a minimum of 10 metres.

Students should bring with them any required medication (asthma inhalers, epipens). Mobile phones and other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk.
