Year 11 Academic Monitoring Report

Based on our Spring Tracking Data, which you received in the last half term, your son is underachieving in a number of subjects.

As a result, your son will be placed on Blue Academic Monitoring Report for the final three weeks of half term, starting on Tuesday 23rd April.

The aim of this report is to monitor your sons contributions and work produced in class, as well as identifying if your son is using time outside of school wisely to revise.

Whilst on report your son will be focusing on the following targets:

1. Complete all classwork to a high standard (and to the best of ability);
2. Make positive contributions to class discussions.

I would like to reiterate that this report should not be seen as a punishment. It has been put in place to help support your son over the next three weeks and that he has regular conversations with teaching staff and can help identify any specific support required

At the end of each day there is a section in the report for parents to note down any work/home learning that students have done outside of school. Please can you ensure that you are engaging in conversation with your son with regards to the work that he is completing at home.

All homework that Year 11 are set is on Show My Homework and this is available for you to access. Please contact Mr Wills if you require your login for this.

All students have had the opportunity to access past papers in Maths and Science, as well as past papers across a range of subjects being available online. As you will also be aware there are a number of online learning resources that your son has access to including PixL Maths, Seneca Learning, Mymaths and mygcscience. I also hope that your son will find the Easter revision useful.

Should there be any topic areas within subjects that your son identifies as an area they need further support in, then this can be noted on the report too.
