London Zoo

As part of the GCE A Level Biology course the Biology Department are organising a visit to London Zoo. This will give students an opportunity to observe a variety of animals and also take part in a lecture on Conservation and Zoos. The lecture is specifically designed to address elements of the Edexcel specification. We believe it is a good opportunity for our students to reinforce their understanding of some essential information.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 17th July at a cost of **£11**. The students need to meet at the entrance to St John's Wood underground station at **9:30am**. The visit is expected to finish at approximately 2:30pm when students are responsible for making their own way home from London Zoo. Students are also required to provide their own lunch and ensure there is sufficient funds on their oyster card to facilitate the journey.

The visit is completely voluntary. However we believe that this will be a valuable addition to your child's school experience.

Payment should be made via ParentPay and selecting '**London Zoo – 2018/2019**'. Payment should be received by Wednesday 3rd July. Unfortunately we are unable to accept payments after this date.
