Hillingdon Oxbridge Pathway

It is with great pleasure that I am able to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to join the Hillingdon Oxbridge Pathway. This scheme aims to provide Hillingdon students with the tools needed to apply to study at Oxford or Cambridge Universities.

Your son/daughter has been identified as one of the most able students in their Year group. As you will be aware, applications for Oxbridge are very competitive and therefore students need to plan ahead in order to ensure they have the personal attributes and skill-set required, in addition to attaining the high academic grades expected.

Should they be happy to accept a place on this scheme, your son/daughter will be required to participate in two upcoming events in July and September.

Oxbridge Preparation - Half-day Seminar:

On **Monday 8th July 2019** students will be required to attend a half day seminar session aimed at route-mapping preparations for Oxbridge. This will take place at Haydon School. Students will meet in the Hub at **8:15am** and will travel by minibus to Haydon School. Students will be provided with lunch before returning to Bishop Ramsey at approximately **1:00pm** where they will re-join their lessons until the end of the school day.

Students should bring a pen, notepad and USB stick to the seminar.

Cambridge University - Taster day:

On **Thursday 26th September 2019** approximately 100 students from across Hillingdon will spend the day at Cambridge University. The visit will include a tour of Robinson College, an undergraduate Q&A panel and an academic taster session.

Students will need to arrive at Haydon School at **7:30am** on Thursday 26th September (the coaches will leave promptly at 8:00am). Students should bring a packed lunch with them along with a notebook and pens. Students will return to Haydon School at approximately **4:30pm** where they will be dismissed to make their own way home. There will be no cost for the trip.

You confirm:


- That your son/daughter's medical details are correct on the Parent Portal and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip

All students who travel as part of a group represent Bishop Ramsey School, therefore the highest standards of behaviour and conduct are expected as a matter of course. School uniform should be worn for both trips.
