Please see the information below from the Rotary Club regarding examples of suitable items:

Younger Children (Boys or Girls)

Cars, trucks, etc, balls, complete jigsaws, action figures, colouring books, pens, crayons, Lego blocks, yo-yo's, bubble blowers, wooden and plastic toys, building blocks, pencil case, pencil sharpener, dominoes, modelling clay, plasticine and cutters, fluffy toys, dolls, stickers, writing pads, skipping rope, scarf, mittens/gloves, hat, harmonica, games, cards, etc.

Teenagers (Boys or Girls)

Sportswear, scarf, gloves, socks, hat, football memorabilia, writing materials, games, playing cards, tennis balls, toothbrush and toothpaste, roll-on deodorants, comb, mirror, costume jewellery, make-up, hair brush, toiletries, school stationery, clothing repair kits, sketch pad, coloured pens/pencils, etc.

What not to include

Please do not include the following: Food, sweets, chocolate and drinks, battery operated toys, conflict related items, matches, inflammable liquids, inflammable aerosols (e.g. deodorants and hair spray).
