The report includes a subject comment, grades for Attitude to Learning, Fine Predictions and UCAS Grade. An explanation of the fine grading system and a key to the Attitude to Learning is included on the report.

Predicted Grades are colour coded against their Year Target such that;

	At Year Target
	Below Year Target
	Significantly below Year Target

UCAS grades are the grades that are submitted to universities if or when students make a university application. They are one of the factors that universities will use when deciding whether to make students an offer. These grades are based on the student's performance across the year and not just the most recent exams. Staff put a lot of thought into their UCAS predictions and whilst being optimistic, they also have to be grounded in data and realism. It maybe that the predictions as they are, prevent access to certain courses. This is not intentional, but is part of the process when looking at suitable and realistic post-18 qualifications. As a school, we will not be able to raise predictions just based upon student/parental requests as it is very much in the interests of the students for their grades to be realistic. However, if you feel that the grades provided to your son/daughter are inappropriate, please contact Mr Jeffries to discuss this matter or ask your son/daughter to speak to Mr Jeffries at school

We should like to congratulate students who are doing as well or better than could be expected and ask for your support where we believe that your son/daughter could do better.
