Canterbury Choir Trip – Thursday 14th October 2021

I am writing to inform you that, as part of Canterbury Choir and Chaplaincy, your child will be involved in leading the worship as part of The Annual Conference for Anglican Academy and Secondary School Heads at The Royal Foundation of St Katherine, Limehouse.

It is a great honour to have been selected for this role as they have only selected two schools for the three day conference.

The service takes place on Thursday 14th October at 10:30am and students will travel from school with staff to the event. We will meet at school for 7:30am for a prompt departure. We will travel via the tube and DLR so students will require their oyster zip card with sufficient funds to facilitate the outward journey. For the return journey, we are able to use the TFL free travel scheme due to the time of travel. Students will return to school after the service at approximately 1.30pm where they will attend lessons for the remainder of the day.
