I am pleased and excited to announce the following activities for this summer's Enrichment Days:

Thursday 14th July – Queens Bowling & Science Museum

Day one will be split in half with the students having the opportunity to go bowling and visit the Science Museum. On day two, the students will visit the theme park and zoo of Chessington World of Adventures. Whilst at Chessington the students will be given free time throughout the day to explore the rides and attractions of the Theme Park.

You confirm:

- That you understand that if your son/daughter's behaviour in school is not acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.

Students should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk.
