Maths Trip to Harry Potter World, Warner Bros Studios - Monday 11th July

As a recognition of your son/daughter's progress and effort in Maths over the past year, we have invited a few select students from Years 7 and 8 to attend a reward trip to Harry Potter World. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a Maths and Engineering lesson to learn about how Maths is applied in the movie industry. Students will then tour the studios and see behind the scenes of the movie making world.

The trip will take place on Monday 11th July. We will travel to Warner Bros Studios by coach and will be leaving school at **8.00am**, we will return to school at approximately 3.30pm, where students will be dismissed to make their own way home. As spaces are limited, they will be allocated on a first come first serve basis on receipt of payment.

Please note that upon making your payment you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions associated with this trip:

Your permission is granted for your son/daughter:

- To attend the trip
- To be given a mild painkiller (eg. Paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader
- To received medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carer you
- cannot be contacted

You confirm:

- That your son/daughter's medical details are correct on Arbor and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip
- That you understand that if your son/daughter's behaviour in school is not acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.

There is a requirement for your son/daughter to wear full school uniform on the day. Students will also be required to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle. There is a shop onsite for students to buy souvenirs and light refreshments if they chose.

Your son/daughter should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be brought but students do so at their own risk.
