Year 11 Prom and Yearbook

I am writing to provide you with further details about the Year 11 Prom. As communicated in a previous letter, the Prom will take place on Friday 1st July 2022.

After a few challenging years where events and trips have been impacted by Covid, I am delighted that the Year Group will have the chance to celebrate their time at school at the Prom. It is sure to be a fantastic and memorable evening which I have no doubt will be enjoyed by all.

As always, the Prom will be a formal event, held in the School Hub starting at 6:30pm. Parents are welcome to attend to watch and take photos of the students arriving from the designated viewing points. The event will finish at 10:00pm, please arrange for your son/daughter to be collected promptly.

Previous events have been excellent fun and well attended, with students always behaving impeccably. With that in mind, the Prom will be a strictly no alcohol event. It is important that students are aware that they will be refused admittance and sent home if they attempt to bring alcohol into the event, or if they arrive at the Prom and have obviously been drinking.

The cost of admittance to the Prom is £17.00, which includes a buffet, refreshments and the evening's entertainment.

Attendance at the Prom is a privilege not a right. This means that we will be monitoring student behaviour and attendance very carefully in the coming weeks. Issues that would result in the right to attend being withdrawn were outlined in my previous letter.

To further commemorate your son/daughters time at Bishop Ramsey we are in the process of creating a fantastic Leavers' Yearbook full of photographs and memories, the cost of this is £16.00.

If you reach the ParentPay payment receipt page, then your payment should have been successful. If you are in any doubt, login and access 'My accounts' which gives you a history of the payments you have made.
