### **Sixth Form Psychology and Sociology Trip New York - Easter 2023**

Bishop Ramsey are very pleased to be able to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to take part in a 5 day trip to New York to visit sites that have been specifically chosen to enrich the Psychology and Sociology specifications for Sixth Form students. This trip will take place at the start of the Easter holidays between **Friday 31st March and Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2023**. The trip will be open to all students studying Psychology or Sociology subjects in Year 12 or 13 at the time of the trip.

The trip is of course voluntary, but we believe it will provide an excellent opportunity to explore key study themes such as immigration, terrorism, social change and the civil rights movement. Additional tourist activities include a ferry to the Statue of Liberty, and a breath-taking view from the 'Top of the Rock.'

The cost of the trip will be approximately £1,600 with the final price and the viability of the trip going ahead being dependent on minimum numbers being reached. The price includes air travel, all internal travel, accommodation, all entrance fees and tours as well as breakfast each day and two evening meals while in New York.

Deposits are not yet required, as we want to ensure that we can provide an equal opportunity to students who will be starting the Year 12 Psychology and/or Sociology courses in September 2022. We will therefore write again in September to finalise arrangements and provide details of how to secure your son/daughters' place and pay the initial **non-refundable deposit of £400. Please note this item will not appear on ParentPay until we have notified you of this in September 2022.**

Additional payments (approximate) will be due as follows:

Mid November 2022                      £600

End January 2023                        £600

This trip has **limited availability** and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis as deposits are received. Should the maximum number be reached before the deadline, the item will be closed on ParentPay and no further deposits will be accepted.

Naturally, we expect a high standard of behaviour from all students on school trips. The school reserves the right to exclude students from a trip if their behaviour does not meet with the standards expected on a day-to-day basis in school.
