Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 10 History - Jack the Ripper Tour, Whitechapel, London

I have pleasure in inviting your son/daughter to a daytime 'Jack the Ripper' tour in Whitechapel, London. The trip will take place on Wednesday 29th June (Mrs Boddington and Miss Robinson's classes) and Thursday 30th June (Miss Hudson and Mrs Ryan's classes).

On the tour we will explore the dark alleyways and sinister thoroughfares where the Jack the Ripper murders occurred in 1888. The guides will show us actual Victorian photographs (several of them unique to the tour) of the very streets through which we will be walking so we can see them as they were at the time of the murders. The tour guides are experts on the subject and several of them are published authors on the Jack the Ripper murders. They are familiar with every twist and turn of this intriguing murder mystery!

Students are to meet staff under the sail after registration at 9.10am. We will then walk to Ruislip Manor Station where we will catch the tube to Aldgate. The tour starts at 11.00am outside Aldgate station and will finish at 12.40pm. **Please ensure that your son/daughter has their Oyster card with sufficient funds to facilitate the journey.**

Students are required to take a packed lunch with them to eat on the journey home. We will be back in school before the end of the day, so students will resume lessons as per normal. Students will be expected to wear their uniform with their Bishop Ramsey lanyard. Students should also have a raincoat or sunscreen, depending on the weather conditions on the day.

The cost of this trip is £10.50. Payment should be made via ParentPay, selecting 'Year 10 Jack the Ripper Tour – 2022'. Payment should be received by **Sunday 5th June**. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept payments after this date.
