Chaplaincy Adventure Weekend –Years 8 & 9

I am pleased to be able to offer your son/daughter a place on the Chaplaincy Residential.

The Adventure Residential is from Friday 30th September to Sunday 2nd October at Woodrow High House, Amersham.

Woodrow High House is a newly refurbished Grade II listed Manor house situated in 26 acres of land on the edge of the Chilterns. The weekend will include Nightline, High Ropes and Bush Craft and a bonfire alongside some reflective chapel sessions.

The total cost of the trip/visit is £145.50. In order to secure your son/daughters place, please make an initial **non-refundable** deposit of **£60 by Monday 11th July 2022**. An additional payment of £85.50 will be required by 5th September 2022. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept payments after this date.

Please note that upon making your payment you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions associated with this trip:

Your permission is granted for your son/daughter:

- To attend the trip
- To be given a mild painkiller (eg. Paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader
- To received medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carers you cannot be contacted.

You confirm:

- That your son/daughter's medical details are correct on Arbor and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip
- That you understand that if your son/daughter's behaviour in school is not acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.

We will travel to the venue by coach, leaving school at 3.15pm of the Friday. Students would need to be collected by their parents/carers from Woodrow High House, Amersham at approximately 2.00pm on Sunday 2nd October.

Students will be sleeping in boys or girls dorm rooms with others in their Year group.
