


Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 9 Summer Report

Your child's Report will be available to view from Friday 1st July after 5.00pm, by logging into the Arbor Parent Portal <https://bishop-ramsey-cofe.uk.arbor.sc>. Under quick actions please select report card, you will then be able to select the report card and download to either view, save or print.

Your child will also be able to see their report by logging into their Arbor account under my items - my reports.

The tracking sheet includes the new style reporting system for Attitude to Learning (which is no longer colour coded) with a scale from 0-4 where 0 suggests there are causes for concern and 4 being used in exceptional circumstances to indicate outstanding attitudes at all times. Predictions are also provided, which are colour coded against the individual student's year target for their pathway. (see progress colour-coding key below) We are using a system where the student's current progress is used to indicate whether they are currently on track to achieve above, at or below their target. Further details on this are given within the report itself.
