Year 10 Enrichment Days - Final Details

I am writing to confirm details of next week's Enrichment Days.

On Thursday 14th July Year 10 will be participating in their Enrichment Programme. Every student in Year 10 has written a CV and applied for a potential job via a letter. Based on this information, they will be interviewed by someone from the world of business for that position and receive constructive feedback on their performance. Students will also take part in a series of employability tasks, including an enterprise challenge. The entire day will be organised on a competitive basis and students will be judged on skills such as working in a team, presentation skills and creative thinking. We are trying to encourage students to appreciate the realities of the workplace environment. **To this end, students should dress appropriately for an interview in formal business wear.** Students will need to arrive at school at the usual time of 8.35am and the day will finish at 2.55pm.

Food will be available to purchase in the Hub as per usual on Thursday.

On Friday 15th July we will be attending Thorpe Park. Coaches will leave promptly in the morning at **8.40am**, so students must arrive at school by **8.30am** to avoid missing the coach. If a student misses the coach in the morning, they will be expected in school for the day. We will be leaving Thorpe Park at 3.00pm and I envisage we will be back at school by around 4.00pm, where students will be dismissed to make their own way home. **Please note, parents of any student who misses the return coach will be billed for any transportation costs incurred.**

Students are free to wear their own clothes to Thorpe Park, however the same expectations that apply to non-uniform days will apply. Students may bring a packed lunch, or purchase lunch from one of the many food outlets within the park. Students who usually have a free school meal will be offered a packed lunch prior to the trip. Sunscreen or a raincoat may be required, depending on the weather.

Students will be free to enjoy the park without direct supervision, however any poor behaviour will result in students losing this privilege. Bishop Ramsey staff will be available at a designated meeting point throughout the day.

Please ensure your child brings with them any medication they may require, including asthma inhalers and epipens. Mobile phones and other items of value may be taken but students do so at their own risk.
