**Year 12 Enrichment Day – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July – Work from Home Day**

Next week are the annual school Enrichment Days. On Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> July, Year 12 are heading to Thorpe Park, or attending the Geography Field trip.

On Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July, students are working from home, but with a particular focus. That focus is post-18 options and in recent PSHE lessons, students have been presented with information on how to complete their UCAS application and their personal statement. Therefore, students should use Friday to ensure that they have completed the first draft of their personal statement on UniFrog. It has been explained to students that we expect this to be completed by the end of term. As mentioned at the recent post-18 options evening, this process is useful for students even if they do not intend on attending University as the skills link directly to parts of the application process for apprenticeships and full-time employment. If students have already completed a first draft, we suggest that the time is used to complete online courses and wider reading linked to their post-18 option, or their Year 13 study. More guidance on this and personal statements will be emailed to students directly on their school email.

Please note that students are unable to work on the school site on either day due to other activities taking place and the reduced number of staff on site.
