**The Natural History Museum, South Kensington**

- Students will need to be at school at **8.30am** ready to depart to Ruislip Manor Station
- We will be returning to Ruislip Manor Station at **3.00pm**, where students will be dismissed to make their own way home.
- Students will walk around the Museum in pre-set groups. Students must stay in these groups at all times whilst in the Museum. Whilst in the Museum students should consider that the Museum is also open to members of the public

## **Additional Information**

We will be travelling by London Underground to all venues. Your son/daughter will require their oyster card. Please ensure that your son/daughter has sufficient funds on their oyster card to facilitate the journey on both days.

Depending on which route your son/daughter's group takes back at the end of the day, they may be able to get off the train at a station closer to home, rather than Ruislip Manor/South Ruislip. If you would like your son/daughter to get off the train at a different station, please indicate this via this [link](#).

Students should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk.

Students must bring their school **lanyard and ID card** with them, to be able to identify Bishop Ramsey students at both venues. Students are free to wear their own clothes, however the same expectations that apply to non-uniform days will apply.

All students who travel as part of a group represent Bishop Ramsey School. Therefore, the highest standards of behaviour and conduct are expected as a matter of course.
