Super Curricular – Year 11

I am delighted to invite your child to attend a talk during their Form Time PSHE lesson on Friday 21st October with staff from our link college, Peterhouse from Cambridge University.

During this session, students will learn about the benefits of going to university, how to choose A Level subjects and how they lead to a degree as well as how different degrees lead to careers. As well as giving students a flavour of Cambridge University, it will also support them with thinking about their A Level options more broadly.

This talk is the first of many opportunities students will have as they learn about competitive applications at university and the need for super curricular activities. Throughout this year, I will be working with students as they make choices for post 16 study and if they choose to progress into the Sixth Form at Bishop Ramsey, students will receive regular sessions during Form Time to prepare for these competitive university applications.

In the Sixth Form, students will receive talks from different universities, support, and guidance with preparing their applications for potential early entries. I am also part of the team that supervises the EPQ which gives students the opportunity to independently research a topic they are interested in, which feeds into the super curricular activities required for these top universities.

Later this year, I will be running a parent/carers Information Evening regarding competitive applications and the Oxbridge application process to ensure that parents/carers and students are informed about their options and the support available at Bishop Ramsey in the Sixth Form.
