Aspiring High Achievers in Science – Year 11

I am writing to you regarding an initiative we are setting up in Science called '**Aspiring High Achievers in Science**' to help students reach their full potential. Selected students have been identified using their Year 10 end of year exams and current GCSE predicted grades. **Your child has been identified as having the potential to achieve their aspirational target in Science, but currently working slightly below this level.**

This initiative involves your child attending weekly after school sessions on a **Thursday** in the run up to the PPE exams.

The aims of the '**Aspiring High Achievers in Science**' initiative are to provide selected students with:

- Guidance on effective revision strategies that they can use to achieve their full potential
- Short, weekly sessions (30 minutes) on Thursday after school to develop their knowledge and understanding of the key areas of the Science curriculum in preparation for the December PPE exams
- Tailored sessions, focusing on exam skills, key terminology and subject content.
