Sixth Form Theatre Trip – ‘Cabaret’

We hope that this letter finds you well.

As part of the A Level Drama course, we invite your child to attend a theatre trip to watch ‘Cabaret’ at The Kit Kat Klub in The Playhouse Theatre, London on Wednesday 7th December at 2:00pm. Students will leave school at 12.25pm. We will travel to the theatre together using London Underground. As this is an A Level trip, students will be able to travel back independently, but are more than welcome to travel back to school with myself if they do not feel confident to travel back alone. We expect to get back to Ruislip Manor at approximately 6.00pm.

The benefits for attending this trip for A Level Drama students is the opportunity to experience live theatre. As part of students A Level component 3 written exam, section A requires them to write a live theatre review and gaining first-hand experience of the performance and production elements will aid their knowledge and understanding of the process. We also feel that as Drama students, the opportunity to visit and see a show in London’s West End would be invaluable.

Your permission is granted for your child:

- To be given a mild painkiller (eg. Paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader
- To received medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carer you cannot be contacted.

You confirm:

- That your child’s medical details are correct on Arbor and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip
- That you understand that if your child’s behaviour in school is not acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.
