A Level Economics Revision Workshop – Haydon School, Northwood Hills

We are pleased to offer your child the opportunity to take part in a two-day A Level Economics workshop held in St Mary's Hall, Haydon School, Wiltshire Lane HA5 2LX on Friday 24th and Saturday 25th February 2023 from 9.30am – 3.30pm

The trip is completely voluntary; however, this Economics workshop will provide students with a highly valuable and motivational revision on both days that will focus on key content and exam skills.

The workshop will be provided by an external provider, 'Econplusdal'. He is a renowned author and educator in the field of economics and runs a very successful Youtube channel on which he helps students in the UK best comprehend Economics concepts and build examination skills to score top grades in A Level Economics examinations.

The workshop will be both revision and activity-based; the students will learn through practical activities and by working through all topics covered since Year 12. Day 1 will focus on core Year 12 content and Day 2 will focus on the National Economy. There will also be a persistent focus throughout the two days on Exam Technique and Writing Skills for top grades and regular interaction.
