Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 13 Computer Science Trip, Escape Hunt - 16th January 2023

We are pleased to inform you that we have arranged a trip to an escape room for Year 13 Computer Science students on Monday 16th January 2023. The venue is Escape Hunt, Unit R4 Atria, Watford, WD17 2AU. The focus for the day will be Problem Solving and Decomposition. This will lead on to a short project we will complete on designing your own Escape Room.

Students are to travel to and from Escape Hunt independently. They should meet staff at the venue at 9.45am for a prompt 10.00am start. The Watford Metropolitan line station is a 20 minute walk from Escape Hunt, details of which can be found via this link [THE ADVENTURE STARTS HERE | Escape Hunt Watford](#). The session will finish at 11.30pm when students should make their way back to school and resume the days lessons.

We have tried to keep the costs to a minimum. The trip is not compulsory, and students can still complete the project without attending.

The cost of this trip is £21.75 which includes a student discount. Payment should be made via Parent Pay, selecting 'Year 13 Computer Science Trip – 2022/23'. Please note that upon making your payment you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions associated with this trip:

Your permission is granted for your child:

- To attend the trip.
- To be given a mild painkiller (eg. Paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader.
- To receive medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carer you cannot be contacted.

You confirm:

- That your child's medical details are correct on Arbor and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip.
- That you understand that if your child's behaviour in school is not acceptable then they may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.

Students should have their Oyster card with sufficient funds to facilitate the journey and their school lanyards which are used as a student ID to secure the discounted price. They will also be required to bring a packed lunch and water on the day.
