**Year 7 & 8 Maths Trip to Harry Potter World, Warner Bros Studios
Friday 23rd June 2023**

As recognition of your child's progress and effort in Maths over the past year, we have invited a few select students from Years 7 and 8 to attend a reward trip to Harry Potter World. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a STEM lesson and learn about how Maths is applied in the movie industry, students will then tour the studios and see behind the scenes of the movie making world.

The trip will take place on Friday 23rd June. We will travel to Warner Bros Studios by coach and will be leaving school at 8.15am and will return to school at approximately 3.00pm, where students will be dismissed to make their own way home. As spaces are limited, they will be allocated on a first come first served basis on receipt of payment.

There will be a requirement for your child to wear school uniform. Students will also be required to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle on the day. There is a shop onsite for students to buy souvenirs and light refreshments if they wish.

The cost of this trip is **£36.83** and payment should be made via Parent Pay, selecting '**Year 7 & 8 Maths Reward Trip – 2023**'. Payment must be received by **Thursday 19th January**. You confirm:

- That you understand that if your child's behaviour in school is not acceptable then they may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.
