Year 13 Curriculum Day – Escape Room

The Science Department are very excited to be organising the Curriculum Day for Year 13 on **Friday 3rd March 2023**. The day will consist of an escape room at ClueQuest in Central London together with a treasure hunt around the area.

Students will have the opportunity to work together and solve clues in order to escape Science themed escape rooms and treasure. The aim of the day is to develop teamwork, communication and problem-solving skills as well as to have some fun.

For the escape rooms, students will attend one of three time slots available and take part in one of the 4 escape rooms. There will be prizes for the team that escapes the fastest.

The treasure hunt will be based outdoors. Students will need to solve clues to guide them to the correct locations to find the next clue. There will be prizes for the fastest group.

Students will need to make their own way to and from the venue in King's Cross, London at their allocated times. More information on timings and groupings will be given closer to the time of the event. We recommend students dress comfortably for the day. Please ensure that your child has their Oyster card with sufficient funds to facilitate the journey.

Attendance on the curriculum day is mandatory. We strongly encourage students to participate and enjoy the day, however if students do not attend the trip, they will be expected to be in school all day.
